

Figure 1. Regions





Figure 2. Reason for Child Care



12-Month Average December 2019 - November 2020







Figure 3. Children Served by Facility

12-Month Average December 2019 - November 2020







Figure 4. Children Served by Provider

12-Month Average December 2019 - November 2020





Figure 6. Child Care Payments





Figure 7. Children Served By Region



12-Month Average December 2019 - November 2020







Figure 9. Children Served Age < 2 By Facility

12-Month Average December 2019 - November 2020







Figure 10. Children Served Ages 2-5 By Facility





Figure 11. Children Served Ages > 5 By Facility




Figure 12. Children Served in Center By Age




Figure 13. Children Served in Family Home By Age




Figure 14. Children Served in Group Home By Age



Figure 15. Transitional Households by Level November 2020





Figure 16. Transitional Children by Level November 2020

Figure 17. Children Served By Provider Type




Figure 18. Child Care Providers By Type






Figure 20. Households by Reason for Care





Figure 21. Children by Reason for Care
